

Now that most of you have your tubers and cuttings here are some hints.

- Tubers do not need a lot of water right after they have been planted. They will be happy getting watered when you plant and probably not need much until they come up. Giving them too much water when they are first putting out their feeding roots can make these roots rot.
- Cuttings will need watering from the beginning because they are already rooted.
- Make sure to put down bait for snails, slugs and earwigs. They will make a salad out of your newly growing plants.






