Minutes ---

Motion made and passed to accept after clarification that January meeting will include pot luck dinner. Reminder to members to bring own plates, silverware and "dish" to be shared. Dinner to start at 6:30 followed by a short meeting.

Beverly presented new member, Diane Bond, with \$20.00 gift certificate to be used at tuber sale.

Chris --- Both presented and demonstrated digging, cutting and dividing dahlias.



When digging, allow for wide space around plant to avoid slicing into plant's tubers.

Curtis showed special knife for this process, going out about 10-12inches to dig.

Be aware that rotting may occur if left in the ground and it becomes saturated with water as well as infestation of bugs, like slugs. If tuber has significant hollow interior, this too may fill with water and rotting may begin.

Once clump removed, need to get dirt off. Wash with water and disinfect cut tubers with solutions using bleach {1:10} can be used for this.

Guy assisted Chris then in showing ways of removing dead tubers. He reminded everyone that the tuber neck is sensitive area of tuber, to avoid breaking off.

There were plenty of tuber clumps brought in to give opportunity for members to try their hand at cutting.

Curtis followed with video of various dahlia forms/shapes.

Raffle ticket drawing done. Prizes will be new dahlia varieties and hopefully the winners will grow and then bring in tubers next year. This will hopefully promote membership in the club.

Beverly did second raffle with useful or fun items to garden with. This based on getting yearly dues in early.
