Ellen opened the meeting at 7:08 after a great discussion of crows.

Welcome by John -Linda Bailey introduced herself. She is a tax preparer. Zero to hero at a dinner party bringing dinner plate dahlias. Welcome, Linda!

John said this was a good teaching time as dahlias are on their way out. Literally.

President's report: (John) Not much going on. The tree dahlia is the only dahlia blooming!!

Treasurer report: Dennis reported all membership checks are deposited. Checking account is liquid (much of it will go to ADS) CD: Is doing well. Dennis is looking for another person to be on the account with him. They will check to see if John is ... he was at one time.

Minutes were sent out, but we did not get them. We will re-distribute and approve them next time.

Membership: Diane reported 47 members from 2021. 23 members for 2022. Please send checks to Diane. She wants all memberships in by the end of December.

Raffle prizes are encouraged. Curtis donated stuff. Thank you.

PSW conference: John is concerned about the annual conference in February as it is our turn to host it. We want to be safe, so we will hold off and see how things progress. We are in limbo and will look forward to a good safe conference. Bylaws say the conference must be in February. It might be too cold to be outdoors. Societies are polling members for interest. Consensus seems to be to wait and see the interest from other societies.

Field cuttings ... Roy Stier presented ... With a new pacemaker, Roy handed his care of his dahlias to his daughter. Time to cut back. She cut his dahlias differently than he does ... 12 inches high rather than 2-3 inches. Two weeks later ... new shoots all over the stalks! He could take cuttings! He took 90 cuttings and will do another 50. Liquid fertilizer to get more roots. He's hoping for 25 % cuttings to root. Cuttings can make more cuttings, exponentially. Amazing!

This year, Roy will leave 25 % of his plants in the ground. He has seen other growers succeed with this method. He will leave three shoots rather than one shoot as some growers have suggested. Second, Roy will leave some partially dug and divide later.

Third, dig, divide and take cuttings (his traditional way of doing things)

Dahlia of the year: John explained the dahlia of the year. One fully double and one open center that have a special spot in the show. We need to find ones that we might have lots of tubers of the same variety.

Options for disc centered:

Christmas Star - not much available Fancy Pants - Roy and others have it Angel Rowyn - not much is available Beverly moved that Fancy Pants be the disc centered flower of the year. Passed.

Fully double consideration:

Phil - Kristi has lots

Clearview Edie - Roy has some

Curtis moved and Ellen seconded that Phil be our fully double flower of the year. Passed. Note: This was an origination by Roy, named after his father. 🙂 🙂

Conference cont'd ... John and Ellen will check with the other societies to field their interest. The board will convene and make some decisions.

Calendars Ellen will order calendars from the National Capitol Dahlia Society. I's their fund raiser for the upcoming national show. \$8 pick up from Ellen, \$10 shipped. Ellen looked for interest. She will order this Friday.
